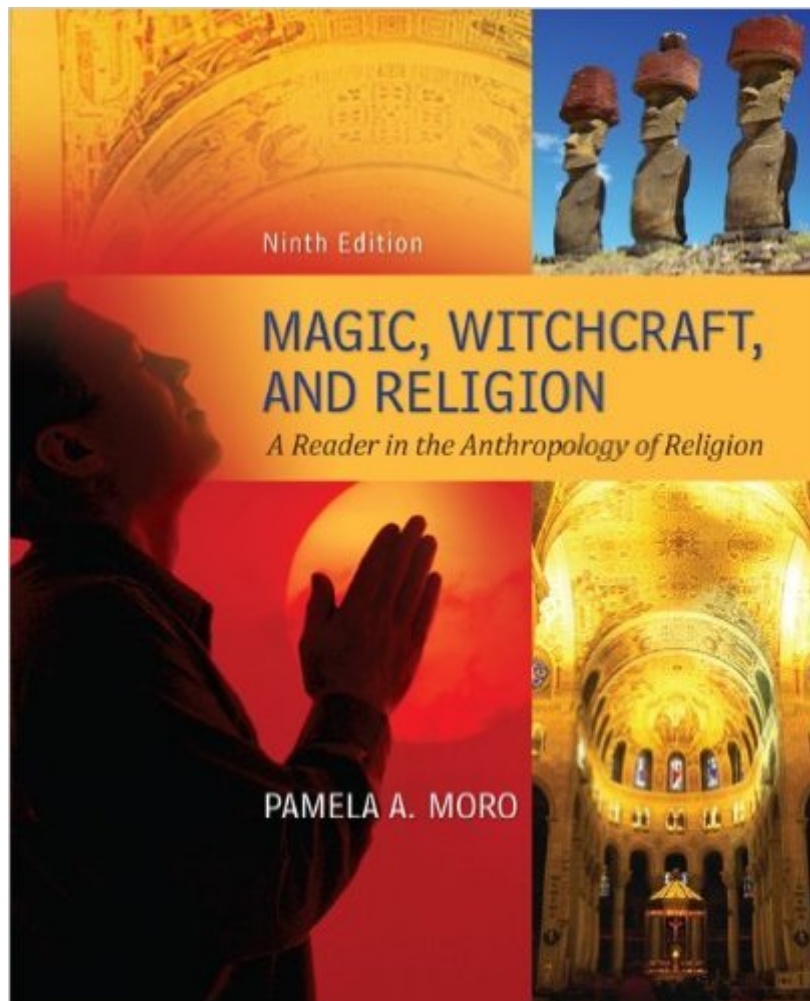


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# Magic Witchcraft And Religion: A Reader In The Anthropology Of Religion
