

This was the only "new" book I purchased for school and the binding was terrible! there are 4 chapters that were inserted too low in the binding process, so I have serrated edging on the top of the short page and material that is important cut off at the bottom of the pages! I needed this book for school, so I didn't return it. It is such poor quality, I won't be able to resell it for sure!Too bad!
